

Membership of **Printing SA** is therefore through the local Chambers which are situated in the major cities of South Africa and non-South African member companies are able to join through the National Directorate or Chamber nearest to their location. It is at Chamber level that most operational assistance is given to our members, this includes regional or provincial issues.

Regional Executive Committee (REC) members are selected by the members in that region and each chairperson of the REC serves on the Printing SA Board of Management.

REC representatives and board members who are elected can only serve for 2 years and are eligible for re-election upon completion of their tenure.
